Checklist

This is a checklist of items you will need in order to connect remotely (via VPN, Virtual Machine, or WebMail)	
	Hardware (PC, Laptop, or Tablet) – EV Issued or Personal Internet Connection (Home Wi-Fi)
	A poor internet connection can be the source of many remote connectivity issues. If you are experiences issues connecting or slowness you can check your internet speed using free sites such as http://www.speedtest.net/ DUO Mobile
_	This must be setup on a cell phone or tablet of your choice whether via an application installed on your mobile device (requires data) or phone call set-up (requires phone service). Devices can be company issued or personal). Instructions for set-up/download can be found on the EV Remote Access Portal, under the 'Instructions tab'
□	Network Username & Password
	Your network password must be up-to-date. An expired password will need to be changed before accessing VPN Remote Access Website
	Bookmark the EV Remote Access Portal page http://evportal.eatonvance.com/ VMware (Optional)
	The VMware Horizon Client application must be installed to access the Virtual Machine Environment. Download is found on the EV Remote Access Portal page
	Call Forwarding
	If needed you can forward your desk calls to your mobile device or home phone. Follow the instructions from the Using the Cisco Phone Console guide located on the EV Remote Access Portal
